QUICK REFERENCE

WATER REQUIREMENTS
Water 1-2 inches every week at least

SUN REQUIREMENTS
6-8 hours

SOIL REQUIREMENTS
Loose, acidic soil

HOW TO PLANT THEM

Pick a site with lots of sun and soil that can drain

Start seeds about six weeks before the last frost of spring

Plant seeds roughly two feet apart

Give them extra water for the first week or so

Pinch the main stem and after you see the first tomato

PESTS TO WATCH OUT FOR

FLEA BEETLE
APHIDS
WHITE FLIES
BLIGHT
END ROT
TOMATO WILTING DISEASE
MOSQUITOES

PRO TIP: Basil is a great companion plant for tomatoes and repels lots of tomato-hungry pests.
